

How to Set the Browser Security of a Survey

Browser Security means that you can allow or disallow your survey takers from taking the printout and making a copy of a survey.

Here's how to enable the Browser Security of a survey:

Step 1: Go to a survey's **Settings >> Security** and locate the option **Browser Security**. You can enable or disable the option to **print** and **copy** a survey.
